A special called meeting of the Etowah City Commission was held on Thursday, April 18, 2013 at 5:45 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 723 Ohio Avenue, Etowah, Tennessee. Members present were Mayor Jim Bull, Commissioner Burke Garwood, Commissioner Dennis Morgan, and Vice Mayor Charles Slack. Commissioner Jim Swayne was not present. Also present was City Manager Matthew Gravley, Finance Director Rebecca Penney and Recording Secretary Eva Valentine.

Mayor Jim Bull called the meeting to order at 5:45 p.m.

NEW BUSINESS

- a. First reading of amended liquor store ordinance 736.

Mayor Jim Bull read in its' entirety, liquor store ordinance 736.

Commissioner Burke Garwood made a motion to accept ordinance 736 as read.

Commissioner Charles Slack seconded the motion and motion carried by a unanimous vote of the city commission.

Mayor Jim Bull announced the second reading of liquor store ordinance 736 will be held on April 29, 2013.

Commissioner Morgan wanted confirmation that one liquor store owner could not own multiple liquor stores within the city. City Manager, Matthew Gravley confirmed that stipulation was included in the original ordinance.
